Medical Emergency

Platform PIC or Project Consultant will:

1. Evaluate Incident Response Level
2. Call Fieldwood Flight Coordinator Medevac Number

Fieldwood Flight Coordinator will:

1. Assess scenario, location and Incident Level
2. Review Medical Condition with Personnel and Field Paramedic

Is Medical Condition Life Threatening or Requires Special Medical Transport?

(Consult Supervisor and MD/Medic to make decision)

Fieldwood Flight Coordinator will:

1. Review all possible Fieldwood transportation resources for medical treatment or transport depending on medical condition

Fieldwood Flight Coordinator will:

1. Call appropriate Medevac provider
2. Receive approval/document with provider and contractor (if necessary)
3. Continue to coordinate flight ops with Platform/Rig
4. Email Fieldwood Personnel of event and ETA
5. Provide update emails until mission is complete

1. Continue to coordinate flight ops with platform/rig
2. Receive approval from contractor (if necessary)
3. Email Fieldwood personnel of Event and ETA

Incident Response Levels

Level	Description	Implication
LEVEL 1	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Minor Injuries or Illnesses (Non-Life Threatening) • Initial assessment of injury or illness indicates possible first aid treatment level care at the facility. • Transport of personnel for this type of injury or illness for precautionary medical evaluation (Field Medic) 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • May Need Air Ambulance. • May Need Assistance During Transport. • Low Priority
LEVEL 2	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Serious Injury or Illness (Non-Life Threatening) • Initial assessment of injury or illness indicates medical treatment needed by Physician or ER. • Patient is alert, in stable condition • Medical treatment is recommended 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • May Need Air Ambulance • Assistance Required During Transport • Medium Priority
LEVEL 3	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Major Injury or Illness (Life Threatening) • Initial assessment of injury or illness indicates medical treatment is needed by Physician or ER. • Immediate medical treatment required 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Air Ambulance Required • Transportation With Medical Assistance Required. • High Immediate Priority
