Smoking Policy

Smoking is only allowed in approved, safe, designated area on platforms or rigs. **This policy is inclusive of electronic cigarettes and vaporizers.**
(Refer to the platform area classification drawing for determining safe smoking area on specific platforms. The Person in Charge(PIC) must approve designated smoking area.)

Requirements

- Designated smoking area shall possess a solid decking within the area to prevent ashes and other smoking debris from migrating into non classified area.
- Approved and designated smoking area must be properly identified and must contain receptacles for safe extinguishment of cigarettes.
- Extinguish **ALL** cigarettes in approved receptacles only, no littering.
- Facilities shall possess only one smoking area to prevent confusion and to ensure that debris is properly discarded.
- **ABSOLUTELY NO SMOKING** is allowed in bedrooms, bunks, galleys, offices containing computers or other electronics (including TV rooms), heliports or any other non-designated area located on Fieldwood Energy premises.
- The only enclosure that personnel will be allowed to smoke in will be a designated smokers shack that has a separate vent intake and/or separate air conditioning unit from the living quarters, galley and/or offices.
- Matches or cigarette lighters shall not be carried into production, drilling, or work areas.
- There shall be no smoking on helicopters or while traveling onboard a work/crew boat that contains flammable materials.
- No Smoking or open flame is allowed outside of boat cabin/quarters when within 100 feet of an offshore structure.

Disregard for designated smoking areas/rules is subject to disciplinary action up to and including termination.
